Good afternoon The Terrace at Canyon Hills Residents,

It has come to the attention of the Board that there has been an increase of PODs being dropped off or stored within the community. Please note that under no circumstance are PODs permitted within the community. The homeowner will be responsible for all damages caused by the POD during delivery, placement, standing and removal. Damages to the area will be charged to the homeowner (gouges, scratches, indentations, etc.). Any POD is subject to an immediate tow, citation by the patrol company, and the homeowner will be called directly to hearing where a fine may be assessed.

It is the homeowner's responsibility to advise tenants of this prohibition of PODs and parking rules for the community. The homeowner shall have the responsibility to acquaint their tenants and guests with the Rules and Regulations of the Association and the CC&R's as homeowners are responsible for the actions of their tenants.
